Context

Objective

Geographic Scope

- Russia and central Asia

Approach

- Collected and analysed data relating to greenhouse gas emissions, applied international standards and accredited coefficients to produce footprint as a baseline for developing carbon strategy
- Supported HSE management in securing buy-in for rolling out carbon management toolkit and for engaging with government
- Presented project results to Executive Board and facilitated cross-business workshop to reassess investment plan considering the impact of carbon
